***Asthma:**

- If your child does have asthma, please supply an inhaler to be kept in their classroom.
- Medication for asthma will be kept in the classroom. An inhaler should be provided by the parent and it is the parent's responsibility to replace the inhaler on a regular basis, to ensure it is in date and not empty. Inhalers will be kept where the children can have easy access to them. It is preferable that children are able to administer their own inhalers. However, in particularly young children (ie: those children in Foundation Stage or Year 1), a member of staff may assist in administering the inhaler. However, this will only be done if a parent has completed a "Medicine Consent Form" (available from the School Office).
- When your child starts swimming lessons (from Yr 3) you will need to provide a second inhaler in a clear plastic, named bag so that this can be kept at poolside whilst your child is in the pool. Your child will not be able to attend swimming lessons unless they have their inhaler with them.
- For residential trips, you will need to provide two inhalers for your child.
